- I will be prepared to ask for what I need and to receive coaching from Ronit Ashkenazi.
- Ronit Ashkenazi Coaching is independent from Community Acupuncture of Marin, the practice of Traditional Chinese Medicine or acupuncture, and is not related to any care you receive from Ronit Ashkenazi under the practice of acupuncture.
- Payment for coaching is due at the time of service unless otherwise agreed upon.
- I begin feeling into the work we will be doing together when your session is scheduled, therefore I charge a \$50 fee for cancelling a session from 24 - 48-hours prior to your scheduled time. If notice to cancel is given within 24 hours, the entire session fee will be due.
